

Dear Major Sabin:

In reply to your letter of 14 July 1944 requesting assistance in obtaining at least two electric fans for use on your special ward at the Trenton State Prison, arrangements have been made with the Organization and Equipment Allowance Branch of this office to have three fans shipped to you from Chicago on a memorandum receipt. These fans will be shipped by express to you at the Rockefeller Institute in Princeton.

Regarding the pyrethrum bombs, I made arrangements by telephone with the Office of the Quartermaster General this morning to have six additional bombs with valves sent to you at Princeton. Please let me know when these have been received. As it is relatively easy for us to make arrangements for these things from this office, I would rather that you did not correspond directly with the Jersey City Quartermaster Depot or other Army offices. I believe we can help you faster if you will pass such correspondence through this office.
