WITNESS our hands and seals this *28<sup>th</sup>* day of *Sept* 1862.

The condition of this Bond is such, that *Saia Ignatius Bleicher* a Citizen of *Cincinnati County of Hamilton and State of Ohio*, Subject to draft and Military duty desiring to leave said County has been detained by order of *Gov. Tod*. Now if the said *Ignatius Bleicher* on or before the *1<sup>st</sup> day of October* shall return to said County, and report himself as his proper successors if accepted

and demean himself properly as a good and loyal citizen, and support and obey the Constitution and Laws and Government of the United States of North America, then this Bond shall be void, otherwise in full force.
