Conservator's Note

This book was received by the Preservation Lab for housing and minor stabilization. The book is a full leather tightback binding. The textblock is sewn on five supports and is laced into the case with five raised cords along the spine. The book was previously rebacked with leather which has red rotted. The front and back boards are completely detached. The textblock remains in good condition.

The leather used for the previous reback was consolidated with one layer of Klucel G in isopropanol, 3%. No further treatment was conducted and the boards remain detached. The book received a protective CoLibri jacket and was housed in a custom corrugated clamshell.
