Conservator's Note

This single sheet bill of sale was received by the preservation lab for housing. The sheets was dry surface cleaned with an Absorbene smoke sponge. The manuscript ink was tested with indicator paper for iron (II) ions, and tested positive for Fe(II) ion, indicating it is likely iron gall ink. The sheet was previously folded in half and a sheet of dove gray was interleaved between the folded halves. The deed was housed in a polyester L-sleeve and a custom oversized manuscript folder.
