DEAR JIM:—

JUST ANOTHER WEE NOTE BEFORE A WEEK-END SLIPS BY. THANK YOU FOR YOUR NICE LETTER, WHICH BOTH HILDA AND I ENJOYED. WE APPRECIATE YOUR LETTERS SO VERY MUCH.

SO FAR AS I AM CONCERNED A SUBSCRIPTION WAS SENT IN SOME TIME AGO FOR YOUR RADIO GUIDE. I HAVE WRITTEN TO THE MAGAZINE TO FIND OUT WHY YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED IT. I SUBSCRIBED THROUGH ONE OF THE LEADING STORES HERE IN TOWN, AND THERE IS NO REASON WHY YOU SHOULD NOT BE RECEIVING IT EACH WEEK.

YOUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE INTERNATIONAL SITUATION IS REMARKABLY CLEAR, AND I AM SO GLAD YOU HAVE THE CORRECT PICTURE. WE WHO KNOW OUR THEORY AND ARE WELL GROUNDED IN IT COULD NOT HELP BUT SEE CLEARLY WHAT IS HAPPENING AND UNDERSTAND ALL THE FORCES AT WORK. THIS FACT IS MOST HELPFUL TO-DAY, WHEN THE MINDS OF THOSE WHO READ ONLY THE CAPITALIST PRESS ARE SO MUDDLED AND CONFUSED.

I DO NOT UNDERSTAND WHY YOU FEEL IT IS IMPORTANT NOT TO SEND YOU THE MONEY YOU SPENT FOR THE RADIO REPAIRS WHICH IT IS ONLY OUR DUTY TO TAKE CARE OF, AS I SEE IT. I DO NOT WANT TO ACT AGAINST YOUR WISHES, BUT YOU SHOULD PERMIT US TO DO THIS LITTLE THING. YOU ASKED ME TO LET YOU KNOW THE AMOUNT. THE COST OF THE MATERIALS WAS APPROXIMATELY \$9.50, I BELIEVE. I WILL TAKE CARE OF YOUR CABLE, TOO.

I HAVE NOT SEEN ANITA FOR MANY WEEKS. SINCE HER FIRE SHE HAS BEEN BOARDING. THE HOUSE HAS BEEN REPAIRED, HOWEVER, AND IT IS POSSIBLE SHE IS BACK IN IT BY THIS TIME. WE HAD A LOVELY VISIT WITH HER SHORTLY AFTER CHRISTMAS. SHE IS SUCH A RARE AND BEAUTIFUL PERSON.
