Dear friend Frank;

Just a line to you from California. When I wrote you on June the 19 that I hoped it would be possible for you to arrange to take a run down this way to see me as there were several little items that I would like to take up with you in person, I overlooked the main point; it is that if you do get down this way you should come over alone and call for me only.
