The last time you called here you suggested that you take up with our friend Ed some of the things that we discussed; I felt that while he would be willing to do anything that he could he had his hands full and should not be approached for that reason. I learned that you called on him; he was over in person last Saturday and I had a very nice visit with him. Are you working, or has the strikes etc., interfered with your ~~xx~~ business. If it has, I figured that you would be eligible for another visit here by Saturday October 25 and that if you could conveniently get over I would like to have a chat with you.
